6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state officers; amending 74 O.S.  
8 2011, Section 250.4, as amended by Section 3 of  
9 Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1096 of the 2nd  
10 Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature (74 O.S.  
11 Supp. 2014, Section 250.4), which relates to  
12 statewide elected officers; modifying salaries; and  
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 250.4, as  
16 amended by Section 3 of Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1096 of  
17 the 2nd Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature (74 O.S. Supp.  
18 2014, Section 250.4), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 250.4. Pursuant to provisions of the Constitution of  
20 the State of Oklahoma from and after the beginning date of a term of  
21 office which commences in, or after, ~~January 1999~~ January of 2016,  
22 the following officers of the State of Oklahoma shall be annually  
23 compensated for their services, payable monthly, as follows:

24 1. The Governor shall receive a salary ~~equal to the salary~~  
~~received by the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court;~~

1 ~~provided however, the Governor shall not receive any increase in~~  
2 ~~salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution~~  
3 ~~of One Hundred Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$147,000.00);~~

4 2. The Lieutenant Governor shall receive a salary equal to the  
5 ~~salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a~~  
6 ~~population greater than ten thousand (10,000) and less than thirty~~  
7 ~~thousand (30,000); provided however, the Lieutenant Governor shall~~  
8 ~~not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of~~  
9 ~~Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven~~  
10 ~~Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);~~

11 3. The Attorney General shall receive a salary equal to the  
12 ~~salary received by the Presiding Judge of the Court of Civil~~  
13 ~~Appeals; provided however, the Attorney General shall not receive~~  
14 ~~any increase in salary as a result of Section 1 of this resolution~~  
15 ~~of One Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-five Dollars~~  
16 ~~(\$132,825.00);~~

17 4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive  
18 ~~a salary equal to the salary received by a district judge; provided~~  
19 ~~however, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall not~~  
20 ~~receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of~~  
21 ~~Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Twenty-four Thousand~~  
22 ~~Three Hundred Seventy-three Dollars (\$124,373.00);~~

23 5. Each member of the Corporation Commission shall receive a  
24 ~~salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge~~

1 ~~in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000);~~  
2 ~~provided however, the Commissioners shall not receive any increase~~  
3 ~~in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this~~  
4 ~~resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen~~  
5 ~~Dollars (\$114,713.00);~~

6 6. The State Treasurer shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~  
7 ~~salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a~~  
8 ~~population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the~~  
9 ~~State Treasurer shall not receive any increase in salary as a result~~  
10 ~~of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred~~  
11 ~~Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);~~

12 7. The State Auditor and Inspector shall receive a salary ~~equal~~  
13 ~~to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county~~  
14 ~~with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided~~  
15 ~~however, the State Auditor and Inspector shall not receive any~~  
16 ~~increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of~~  
17 ~~this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred~~  
18 ~~Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);~~

19 8. The State Insurance Commissioner shall receive a salary  
20 ~~equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a~~  
21 ~~county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided~~  
22 ~~however, the State Insurance Commissioner shall not receive any~~  
23 ~~increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of~~  
24

1 ~~this resolution~~ of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred  
2 Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00); and

3 9. The Commissioner of Labor shall receive a salary ~~equal to~~  
4 ~~the salary received by a special judge; provided however, the~~  
5 ~~Commissioner of Labor shall not receive any increase in salary as a~~  
6 ~~result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution~~ of One  
7 Hundred Five Thousand Fifty-three Dollars (\$105,053.00).

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in accordance with  
9 the provisions of Section 58 of Article V of the Oklahoma  
10 Constitution.
