13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 250.4, as
15	amended by Section 3 of Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1096 of
16	the 2nd Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature (74 O.S. Supp.
17	2014, Section 250.4), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 250.4. Pursuant to provisions of the Constitution of
19	the State of Oklahoma from and after the beginning date of a term of
20	office which commences in, or after, <del>January 1999</del> <u>January of 2016</u> ,
21	the following officers of the State of Oklahoma shall be annually
22	compensated for their services, payable monthly, as follows:
23	1. The Governor shall receive a salary <del>equal to the salary</del>
2.4	received by the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court;

provided however, the Governor shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$147,000.00);

- 2. The Lieutenant Governor shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population greater than ten thousand (10,000) and less than thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the Lieutenant Governor shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);
- 3. The Attorney General shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by the Presiding Judge of the Court of Civil Appeals; provided however, the Attorney General shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$132,825.00);
- 4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by a district judge; provided however, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-three Dollars (\$124,373.00);
- 5. Each member of the Corporation Commission shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge

in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000);

provided however, the Commissioners shall not receive any increase
in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this
resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen

Dollars (\$114,713.00);

- 6. The State Treasurer shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the State Treasurer shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);
- 7. The State Auditor and Inspector shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the State Auditor and Inspector shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);
- 8. The State Insurance Commissioner shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the State Insurance Commissioner shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of
