17	compensated for their services, payable monthly, as follows:
18	1. The Governor shall receive a salary equal to the salary
19	received by the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court;
20	provided however, the Governor shall not receive any increase in
21	salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution
22	of One Hundred Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$147,000.00);
23	2. The Lieutenant Governor shall receive a salary equal to the
24	salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a

- 1 population greater than ten thousand (10,000) and less than thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the Lieutenant Governor shall 2 3 not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven 4 5 Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);
 - 3. The Attorney General shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by the Presiding Judge of the Court of Civil Appeals; provided however, the Attorney General shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$132,825.00);
 - 4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by a district judge; provided however, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-three Dollars (\$124,373.00);
- 5. Each member of the Corporation Commission shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the Commissioners shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this 22 resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen 23 Dollars (\$114,713.00);

- 9. The Commissioner of Labor shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by a special judge; provided however, the Commissioner of Labor shall not receive any increase in salary as a
