22	Section 250.4 Pursuant to provisions of the Constitution of the

- the following officers of the State of Oklahoma shall be annually compensated for their services, payable monthly, as follows:
- 1. The Governor shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court;

 provided however, the Governor shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$147,000.00);
- 2. The Lieutenant Governor shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population greater than ten thousand (10,000) and less than thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the Lieutenant Governor shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);
- 3. The Attorney General shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by the Presiding Judge of the Court of Civil Appeals; provided however, the Attorney General shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$132,825.00);
- 4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by a district judge; provided however, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of

Each member of the Corporation Commission shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the Commissioners shall not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);
