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6 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Employee
7 Charitable Contribution Act; amending 74 O.S. 2021,
8 Section 7005, which relates to the state agency
9 review committee; modifying termination date; and
10 declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 7005, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 7005. A. The Oversight Committee for State Employee
15 Charitable Contributions shall be composed of the Director of the
16 Office of Management and Enterprise Services, or designee and six
17 state employees, of which two shall be appointed by the Governor,
18 two shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate
19 and two shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
20 Representatives. Members shall serve at the pleasure of their
21 appointing authorities. The provisions of Section 6 of Title 51 of
22 the Oklahoma Statutes shall not apply to appointments to the
23 Committee. The Committee is re-created to continue until ~~July 1,~~

1 ~~2022~~ July 1, 2025, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma
2 Sunset Law.

3 B. The Committee annually shall elect a chairman from its
4 membership. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
5 Services shall serve as chairman until the first such election.

6 C. The Oversight Committee for State Employee Charitable
7 Contributions shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

8 1. Arrange for publication of information about the application
9 process;

10 2. Review applications of federations electing to participate
11 in the State Charitable Campaign and certify that a federation and
12 each of its member agencies meet the eligibility criteria set forth
13 in Sections 7009 and 7010 of this title;

14 3. Notify in writing each of the applying federations of its
15 acceptance or rejection. Provided, if a federation is rejected, the
16 Committee shall provide the reason for rejection of each of the
17 member agencies of the federation;

18 4. Hear appeals of rejected agencies;

19 5. Delegate to the principal combined fund-raising organization
20 the primary responsibility for the staffing and the financial
21 obligations necessary to comply with the provisions of this
22 subsection;

23 6. Develop a pledge card to be used throughout the State
24 Charitable Campaign;

1 7. Select a principal combined fund-raising organization to
2 assist the Committee in gathering and accumulating the applications;
3 and

4 8. Promulgate rules to implement the provisions of the Oklahoma
5 State Employee Charitable Contribution Act.

6 D. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
7 provide such staff support as is required by the Committee.

8 E. The Oversight Committee for State Employee Charitable
9 Contributions is authorized to appoint such advisory councils and
10 task forces as it deems necessary for counsel, advice and review
11 concerning the formulation and administration of the rules,
12 application review process and the implementation of the Oklahoma
13 State Employee Charitable Contribution Act.

14 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
