10 An Act relating to hunting; allowing hunting guides
11 to operate on lands owned or managed by the Oklahoma
12 Department of Wildlife Conservation under certain
13 circumstances; authorizing the Department to
establish fees and promulgate rules; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-214 of Title 29, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. Hunting guides shall be allowed to operate on lands managed
21 or owned by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation where
22 public hunting is allowed.

23 B. The Department may establish reasonable fees and promulgate
24 rules to enforce the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
