An Act relating to hunting; allowing hunting guides to operate on lands owned or managed by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation under certain circumstances; authorizing the Department to establish fees and promulgate rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Hunting guides

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-214 of Title 29, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Hunting guides shall be allowed to operate on lands managed or owned by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation where public hunting is allowed.

B. The Department may establish reasonable fees and promulgate rules to enforce the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
