6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to legislators; amending 74 O.S.
8 2011, Section 4254, which relates to lobbying by
9 state officers and state employees; prohibiting
10 member of Legislature from receiving compensation or
reimbursement for engaging in certain activities for
certain time period; providing exception; and
providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 4254, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 4254. A. No state officer or state employee shall
17 receive any additional compensation or reimbursement from any person
18 for personally engaging in lobbying other than compensation or
19 reimbursements provided by law for that member's job position.

20 B. No member of the Legislature shall receive any compensation
21 or reimbursement from any person for personally engaging in lobbying
22 for a period of two (2) years after the member's term of office has
23 expired, nor shall any such member be eligible to register as a
24 lobbyist during such time period. The provisions of this subsection

1 shall not apply to a former member of the Legislature who is
2 registered as a lobbyist prior to November 1, 2017.

3 C. No member of the Legislature shall be permitted to be
4 employed by, or otherwise receive any compensation or reimbursement
5 from, any entity which directly or indirectly received more than
6 twenty percent (20%) of its annual revenues from the state in the
7 two (2) immediately preceding fiscal years, if the member influenced
8 or could reasonably have been perceived to have influenced the
9 receipt of such revenue by the employing entity.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
