An Act relating to state government; requiring the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to notify state agencies regarding certain actions; permitting agencies to respond regarding certain actions; requiring certain notice; providing certain exception; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Agency policy procedure

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.202 of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. In all instances in which the Office of Management and Enterprise Services changes a policy affecting a state agency, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall provide the affected agency with written notice no fewer than thirty (30) days in advance of the policy's implementation.
- B. During the period after an affected agency has been notified, and prior to the implementation of the policy, the affected agency shall be permitted to respond to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services and request to be exempted from the policy change, or request modifications to the policy. The

affected agency shall be given a final notice in written format explaining any changes to a policy prior to its implementation.

C. The provisions of this act shall not apply to any policy changes made necessary by federal law or policy, or any other policy changes deemed an emergency by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
