9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2011, Section 3-310, as  
11 amended by Section 118, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (29 O.S. Supp.  
12 2016, Section 3-310), is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 3-310. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall include on  
14 each state individual income tax return form for tax years beginning  
15 after December 31, 2001, and each state corporate tax return form  
16 for tax years beginning after December 31, 2001, an opportunity for  
17 the taxpayer to donate from a tax refund for the benefit of the  
18 Oklahoma Wildlife Diversity Program.

19 B. For purposes of this section, "nongame wildlife" means any  
20 species of wildlife not legally classified as a game species or  
21 furbearer by statute or by rule adopted pursuant to statute.

22 C. Except as otherwise provided for in this section, all monies  
23 generated pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be paid to  
24

1 the State Treasurer and placed to the credit of the Wildlife  
2 Diversity Fund.

3 D. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
4 fund for the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission to be  
5 designated the "Wildlife Diversity Fund". The fund shall be a  
6 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall  
7 consist of all monies received under the provisions of paragraph 2  
8 of subsection C of this section by the Oklahoma Wildlife  
9 Conservation Commission. The Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation  
10 Commission is hereby authorized to invest all or part of the monies  
11 of ~~said~~ the fund in any investment permitted by a written investment  
12 policy adopted by the Wildlife Conservation Commission; provided,  
13 all investments shall be made in accordance with the Oklahoma  
14 Uniform Prudent Investor Act. Any interest or dividends accruing  
15 from such investments shall be deposited in the Wildlife Diversity  
16 Fund. All monies accruing to the credit of ~~said~~ the fund are hereby  
17 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma  
18 Wildlife Conservation Commission for the purpose of preserving,  
19 protecting, perpetuating and enhancing nongame wildlife in this  
20 state. Any monies withdrawn from ~~said~~ the fund by the Oklahoma  
21 Wildlife Conservation Commission for investment pursuant to this  
22 section shall be deemed to be for the purpose of preserving,  
23 protecting, perpetuating and enhancing nongame wildlife in this  
24 state. Expenditures from ~~said~~ the fund shall be made upon warrants

1 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
2 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
3 Services for approval and payment.

4 E. If a taxpayer makes a donation pursuant to subsection A of  
5 this section in error, such taxpayer may file a claim for refund at  
6 any time within three (3) years from the due date of the tax return.  
7 Such claims shall be filed pursuant to the provisions of Section  
8 2373 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes and, if allowed, shall be  
9 paid pursuant to the provisions of ~~said~~ the section. Prior to the  
10 apportionment set forth in subsection C of this section, an amount  
11 equal to the total amount of refunds made pursuant to this  
12 subsection during any one (1) year shall be deducted from the total  
13 donations received pursuant to this section during the following  
14 year and such amount deducted shall be paid to the State Treasurer  
15 and placed to the credit of the Income Tax Withholding Refund  
16 Account.

17 F. Pursuant to Section 2368.18 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma  
18 Statutes, the income tax checkoff contained in this section is  
19 hereby reauthorized effective January 1, 2018.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
