12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 231a of Title 44, unless there
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. The Adjutant General, pursuant to authority granted under 42
16	U.S.C. Section 1856a and applicable Army, Air Force or National
17	Guard regulations, may enter into a reciprocal agreement with any
18	city, county, town or municipal corporation or agency of the State
19	of Oklahoma maintaining fire protection facilities in the vicinity
20	of such property, for mutual aid in furnishing fire protection for
21	such property and for other property for which such entity normally
22	provides fire protection.
23	B. Fire protection units will continue under the command and
24	control of their regular chain of command, but the organizational

unit will come under operational control of the fire protection
service authorities of the jurisdiction receiving assistance.

C. Each agreement shall include a waiver by each party of all claims against the other party for compensation for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring in consequence of the performance of such agreement. Any such agreement may provide for the reimbursement of any party for all or any part of the cost incurred by such party in furnishing fire protection for or on behalf of any other party.

D. The Adjutant General shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.

12 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
