AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 5025, is 16 amended to read as follows: 17 Section 5025. A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority may 18 establish, with available funds, a reimbursement methodology that 19 will enhance the reimbursement for services provided to Medicaid 20 beneficiaries in emergency hospitals in rural areas of the state. 21 B. The Authority shall establish, with available funds, a 22 reimbursement methodology that will enhance the reimbursement for 23 maternity care provided to Medicaid beneficiary areas of the state

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with low or no access to maternity care. The Authority shall seek

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1	any federal approval necessary to establish the enhanced
2	reimbursement methodology. The enhanced reimbursement methodology
3	shall take effect upon federal approval and shall terminate three
4	(3) years after the date it takes effect.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
6	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
