NEW LAW 13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4432 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 14 There is hereby created until July 1, 2020, a task force to 15 Α. study and make recommendations to the Legislature on how four-year 16 17 colleges within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education can assist two-year colleges within The Oklahoma State System of Higher 18 Education to save money by offering assistance with administrative 19 services. For the purposes of this section, "administrative 20 services" shall mean the duties of any college employee who has 21 responsibility for administrative functions including but not 22 limited to human resources, purchasing, accounting and information 23 24 technology.

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B. The task force shall be comprised of five (5) members to be appointed as follows:

3 1. One member who represents the business community, appointed4 by the Governor;

5 2. One member who represents a two-year college, appointed by
6 the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;

3. One member who represents a comprehensive university,
appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

9 4. The Chancellor of Higher Education or a designee; and

10 5. The Secretary of Education or a designee.

11 The chair of the task force shall be the Secretary of Education 12 or his or her designee.

C. Appointments to the task force shall be made within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this act. The task force shall conduct an organizational meeting not later than August 31, 2019.

D. A quorum of the task force shall be required to approve any final action of the task force. For purposes of this section, three members shall constitute a quorum.

E. The task force may meet as often as may be required in orderto perform the duties imposed upon it.

F. The meetings of the task force shall be subject to theOklahoma Open Meeting Act.

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G. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation or
 travel reimbursement.

3	H. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall
4	provide staff and administrative support for the task force.
5	I. The task force shall submit a report of its findings and
6	recommendations by July 1, 2020, to the Governor, the President Pro
7	Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
8	Representatives.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
10	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
12	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
