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8	[ Rural Fire Protection Program Fund Act - financial needs - effective date ]
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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 901.56, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 901.56. A. The provisions of this section shall become
15	effective when funds are made available for such purpose. Upon the
16	availability of such funds, the <del>State</del> <u>Oklahoma</u> Department of
17	Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall notify the coordinator of such
18	available funds.
19	B. For the purposes of this section "coordinator" means the
20	rural fire coordinator in each rural fire protection coordination
21	district as defined in Section 901.61 of this title.
22	C. Upon notification of the <del>State</del> Oklahoma Department of
23	Agriculture, Food, and Forestry pursuant to subsection A of this
24	section on or before the last day of June of each year that funds

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1 are available for such purpose, the district coordinators shall 2 consider and determine the relative needs of participants for monies 3 in the Rural Fire Protection Program Fund. Participants shall include incorporated cities under ten thousand (10,000) population 4 5 according to the latest Federal Decennial Census, towns, and legally formed rural fire departments. Based upon the information available 6 7 to him, the coordinator shall certify to the Commissioner of Agriculture the names of the incorporated cities, towns, and legally 8 9 formed rural fire departments which he determines are in need of 10 financial assistance from the Rural Fire Protection Program and the 11 amount required by each in accordance with the provisions of this 12 section. In making this determination and certification, the coordinator shall consider the intent and purpose of the Rural Fire 13 Protection Program Fund Act. No incorporated city, town or legally 14 formed rural fire department shall receive monies distributed from 15 the Rural Fire Protection Program Fund merely for the purpose of 16 accumulation when such monies are not required to accomplish the 17 purposes of this section. 18

D. In making such determination of needs, the coordinator shall
first determine that each fire department to be certified has been
duly formed under the appropriate state statutes.

E. On or before the last day of August of each year, the StateOklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall

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distribute the monies in the Rural Fire Protection Program Fund in
 the manner provided by law.

3 Any amount so distributed from the Rural Fire Protection F. Program Fund to any eligible participant shall be expended only for 4 5 the maintenance of its fire department, the purchase, construction, maintenance, repair and operation of its fire stations, fire 6 7 apparatus and equipment, the purchase, rental, installation or maintenance of fire hydrants, the payment of insurance premiums upon 8 9 fire stations, fire apparatus and equipment, and insurance premiums 10 for injuries or death of fire fighters, as otherwise provided by 11 law. Provided, however, that no monies shall be expended from the 12 fund for any purpose relating to the water supply systems of any participant, nor for the improvement or construction of such systems 13 nor for any other appurtenances relating to the distribution or use 14 15 of such water supply system. Monies so distributed from the Rural 16 Fire Protection Program Fund to any eligible participant may also be expended, in an amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the 17 allocated funds or the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in 18 the aggregate during any period of one (1) year, whichever is 19 larger, for the expense of any fire fighters attending a certified 20 fire school. 21

G. No amount so distributed from the Rural Fire Protection
Program Fund to any eligible participant shall be expended or
obligated for the purchase of land or the construction of buildings

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1 for fire stations unless all obligations previously incurred for 2 such purposes and to be paid from monies distributed from the Rural 3 Fire Protection Program Fund by such eligible participant have been fully paid and satisfied. No monies from the fund shall be expended 4 5 or obligated for the construction of buildings for fire stations unless the participant proposing to expend or obligate monies 6 distributed from the Rural Fire Protection Program Fund for that 7 purpose holds fee simple title, not encumbered by any lien, or holds 8 9 a lease for a period of not less than ten (10) years, with 10 provisions for renewal of the lease annually, to the land on which it proposes to construct any such building. Provided, however, that 11 12 this provision shall not prohibit construction or location of a fire station on land donated in whole or part to the participant for the 13 purpose, and use of Rural Fire Protection Program Fund monies for 14 such construction or location, where the donor has reserved right or 15 reversion of such land under stated conditions, if such use be 16 appropriate and reasonable. 17

H. Amounts so distributed from the Rural Fire Protection Program Fund to any eligible participant shall be expended under the direction of the chief of the fire department upon duly executed vouchers approved as required by law. In no event shall any such monies to be expended for any purpose which does not relate to the permitted purposes specifically stated in this section.

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1	I. Up to ten percent (10%) of the Rural Fire Protection Program
2	Fund may be distributed to eligible participants based on the total
3	number of fire runs or to pay for expenses associated with large
4	fires.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
