A. The Construction Industries Board is hereby 18 re-created to continue until July 1, 2023 2026, in accordance with 19 the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law. The Board shall regulate 20 the plumbing, electrical and mechanical trades, the building and 21 construction inspectors, and the roofing contractors through the 22 powers and duties set forth in the Construction Industries Board Act 23 24

and in the respective licensing or registration acts for such trades, or as otherwise provided by law.

- B. 1. Beginning July 1, 2013, the Board shall be composed of seven (7) members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate, as follows:
 - a. two members shall have at least ten (10) years' experience in the plumbing trade, of which one shall be a plumbing contractor and one shall be a journeyman plumber,
 - b. two members shall have at least ten (10) years' experience in the electrical trade, of which one shall be an electrical contractor and one shall be a journeyman electrician,
 - c. two members shall have at least ten (10) years' experience in the mechanical trade, of which one shall be a mechanical contractor and one shall be a mechanical journeyman, and
 - d. one member shall have at least ten (10) years' experience as a building and construction inspector.
- 2. Members shall be appointed for staggered terms of four (4) years, as designated by the Governor. Members shall continue in office until a successor is appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall fill all vacancies and unexpired terms in the same manner as

2	filled. A member may be removed by the Governor at any time.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
4	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
