6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to extracurricular activities;
8 allowing students enrolled in a charter school or
9 virtual charter school to participate in
10 extracurricular activities offered at the student's
11 resident school district; providing for determination
12 of eligibility; providing definition; providing for
13 codification; providing an effective date; and
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-140.1 of Title 70, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Students enrolled in a charter school or virtual charter
20 school authorized pursuant to the Oklahoma Charter Schools Act shall
21 be eligible to participate in extracurricular activities offered by
22 the resident school district of the student.

23 B. Charter school student eligibility shall be determined in
24 accordance with the resident school district's eligibility rules and
policies and any rules and policies of a private organization or
association that provides the coordination, supervision and

1 regulation of the interscholastic activities and contests of
2 schools.

3 C. For the purposes of this section, "resident school district"
4 shall mean the public school district in which the student resides
5 as defined in Section 1-113 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
