AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to driver licenses; providing for pilot program between the Department of Public Safety and the Oklahoma Department of Career Technology and Education; providing for possible expansion of services; directing Commissioner to adopt curriculum; authorizing certain investigation; directing promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 110.6 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. The Department of Public Safety is directed to develop and implement a pilot program with the Oklahoma Department of Career Technology and Education (CareerTech) to evaluate the potential use of institutions in the CareerTech system to facilitate expansion of driver licenses services availability and training in the State of Oklahoma.
- B. The Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety shall adopt a curriculum of required courses and training to be offered in

1 the CareerTech system to applicants who are interested in becoming a 2 driver license examiner and/or a commercial driver license examiner. 3 The Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety is С. 4 hereby authorized to investigate the possibility of using the 5 institutions of the CareerTech system as training and examination 6 locations in an attempt to make driver license services easier to 7 access across the state. 8 The Department of Public Safety shall promulgate rules to 9 implement and administer the provisions of this section based on 10 requirements set forth in Section 383.75 of Title 47 of the Code of 11 Federal Regulations. 12 SECTION 2.
