14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

16	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. For the purposes of this section:
18	1. "Owners' association" shall have the same meaning as defined
19	in Section 852 of Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and
20	2. "Solar panel" or "solar collector" means a device used to
21	collect and convert solar energy into electricity or thermal energy
22	including but not limited to photovoltaic cells or panels or solar
23	thermal systems.

B. No deed restrictions, covenants, bylaws, or other governing documents of the owners' association shall prohibit or limit, or have the effect of prohibiting or limiting, the installation of solar panels or solar collectors on the rooftop of any property or structure. An owners' association may adopt reasonable rules regarding the placement of solar panels or solar collectors to the extent that such rules do not prevent the installation, impair the functioning, restrict the use, or adversely affect the cost or efficiency of the solar panels or solar collectors.

- C. The requirements of this section shall apply only to rooftops that are owned, controlled, and maintained by the owner of the individual property or structure.
- D. The requirements of this section shall apply to deed restrictions, covenants, bylaws, or other governing documents of the owners' association recorded or otherwise in effect on the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
