6	An Act relating to rural electric cooperatives; establishing maximum rate allowed for utility pole
7	attachments; providing for certain rate increase; establishing responsibility of certain costs;
8	determining maximum rate for certain services; providing limitations on services; providing for
9	codification; and providing an effective date.

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 437.30 of Title 18, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. The rates charged by a rural electric cooperative for
17	attachments to utility poles by communications services providers
18	shall not exceed Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per rural electric
19	cooperative owned pole per year. Beginning on or after the
20	effective date of this act, this rate shall increase only by an
21	amount equal to the increase in the annual recurring rate permitted
22	under rules and regulations adopted pursuant to 47 U.S.C., Section
23	224(d), as amended.

- B. The rates provided in this section shall not include any applicable charges for electric power, which a communications services provider shall pay separately for such services and such services shall be at market rate.
- C. Any rural electric cooperative that attaches to a pole resulting in the relocation of an existing attachment of a communications services provider shall pay for the cost of the relocation of the communications services provider's attachment including pole replacement if necessary, provided that, such attachment was previously in compliance with all agreed upon safety and contractual standards.
- D. Any rural electric cooperative that attaches to any utility pole for the purposes of providing telecommunications or Internet services shall pay an attachment rate equal to the highest rate being paid by any other attacher with the same utility.
- E. No rural electric cooperative shall provide cable television or video services, as defined in Section 22-107.1 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to any municipality without first obtaining a franchise from the city or town.
- 20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
