7	An Act relating to transportation network companies; amending Sections 2, 7 and 16, Chapter 279, O.S.L.
8	2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 2016, Sections 1011, 1016 and 1025), which relate to transportation network
9	drivers; defining certain term; allowing for certain trade dress to be worn by certain transportation
10	network drivers; modifying certain online status; and providing an effective date.

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 279, O.S.L.
15	2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1011), is amended to read as
16	follows:
17	Section 1011. As used in the Oklahoma Transportation Network
18	Company Services Act:
19	1. "Digital network" means any online-enabled application,
20	software, website or system offered or utilized by a TNC that
21	enables the prearrangement of rides with TNC drivers;
22	2. "Online" means the TNC's digital network can actively track
23	the TNC driver's location, assign transportation requests and offer
24	specific transportation requests to the TNC driver.

 $\frac{2}{3}$. "Personal vehicle" means a vehicle that is used by a TNC driver in connection with providing prearranged rides and is:

- a. owned, leased or otherwise authorized for use by the TNC driver, and
- b. not a taxicab, limousine, or other similar for-hire vehicle of a motor carrier service;
- 3. 4. "Prearranged ride" means the provision of transportation by a driver to a rider, beginning when a driver accepts a ride requested by a rider through a digital network controlled by a transportation network company, continuing while the driver transports a requesting rider, and ending when the last requesting rider departs from the personal vehicle. A prearranged ride does not include shared expense carpool or vanpool arrangements or transportation provided using a taxi, limousine, or other for-hire vehicle pursuant to state law;
- 4. 5. "Transportation network company (TNC)" means a business entity licensed pursuant to this act and operating in Oklahoma that uses a digital network or software application service to connect passengers to transportation network company services provided by transportation network company drivers. A TNC does not provide taxicab, limousine, or other similar for-hire motor carrier service. A TNC shall not be deemed to control, direct or manage the personal vehicles or participating drivers that connect to its digital network, except where agreed to by written contract. Further, a

- transportation network company shall not include an individual,

 corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, or other entity

 solely arranging nonemergency medical transportation for individuals

 qualifying for Medicaid or Medicare pursuant to a contract with a

 governmental entity or managed care organization;
 - 5. 6. "Transportation network company driver (TNC driver)" means an individual who:

- a. receives connections to potential passengers and related services from a TNC in exchange for payment of a fee to the TNC, and
- b. uses a personal vehicle to provide prearranged rides to passengers upon connection through a digital network controlled by a TNC in return for compensation or payment of a fee; and
- 6. 7. "Transportation network company passenger (TNC passenger)" means an individual or persons who use a digital network to connect with a TNC driver who provides prearranged rides to the passenger in the driver's personal vehicle between points chosen by the passenger.
- SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 7, Chapter 279, O.S.L. 21 2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1016), is amended to read as follows:
- Section 1016. A transportation network company's software

 application or website shall display a picture of the TNC driver and

- 2 | the prearranged ride before the passenger enters the TNC driver's
- 3 vehicle. A TNC may require the TNC's trade dress be worn by the TNC
- 4 driver or that the TNC company emblem or logo be displayed on the
- 5 | TNC vehicle while in operation to identify the TNC vehicle and
- 6 driver. Such requirement by a TNC shall not in any way alter the
- 7 contractual relationship between the parties or create an
- 8 employer/employee relationship where one was not intended to exist
- 9 by the parties.
- 10 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 16, Chapter 279, O.S.L.
- 11 | 2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1025), is amended to read as
- 12 follows:
- Section 1025. A. On or before July 1, 2015, and thereafter, a
- 14 | transportation network company driver or TNC on the TNC driver's
- 15 | behalf shall maintain primary automobile insurance that recognizes
- 16 | that the driver is a TNC driver or otherwise uses a vehicle to
- 17 transport passengers for compensation and covers the driver:
- 18 1. While the driver is both logged on to and online on the
- 19 TNC's digital network and is able to receive transportation
- 20 assignments and specific transportation requests but is not engaged
- 21 | in prearranged rides; or
- 2. While the driver is engaged in providing prearranged rides.
- B. The following automobile insurance requirements shall apply
- 24 while a TNC driver is both logged on to and online on the TNC's

- digital network and is available able to receive transportation

 assignments and specific transportation requests but is not engaged

 in prearranged rides:
 - 1. Primary automobile liability insurance in the amount of at least Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for death and bodily injury per person, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for death and bodily injury per incident, and Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) for property damage;
 - 2. Uninsured motorist coverage where not waived pursuant to Section 3636 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and
 - 3. The coverage requirements of this subsection may be satisfied by any of the following:
 - a. automobile insurance maintained by the TNC driver,
 - b. automobile insurance maintained by the TNC, or
 - c. any combination of subparagraphs a and b of this paragraph.
 - C. The following automobile insurance requirements shall apply while a TNC driver is engaged in a prearranged ride:
 - 1. Primary automobile liability insurance that provides at least One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for death, bodily injury, and property damage;
 - 2. Uninsured motorist coverage where not waived pursuant to Section 3636 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

3. The coverage requirements of this subsection may be satisfied by any of the following:

- a. automobile insurance maintained by the TNC driver,
- b. automobile insurance maintained by the TNC, or
- c. any combination of subparagraphs a and b of this paragraph.
- D. If insurance maintained by a TNC driver in subsection B or C of this section has lapsed or does not provide the required coverage, insurance maintained by a TNC shall provide the coverage required by this section beginning with the first dollar of a claim and have the duty to defend such claim.
- E. Coverage under an automobile insurance policy maintained by the TNC shall not be dependent on a personal automobile insurer first denying a claim nor shall a personal automobile insurance policy be required to first deny a claim.
- F. Insurance required by this section may be placed with an insurer authorized to do business in this state or with a surplus lines insurer eligible under Section 1100 et seq. of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- G. Insurance satisfying the requirements of this section shall be deemed to satisfy the financial responsibility requirement for a motor vehicle under Chapter 7 of the Oklahoma Highway Safety Code of Section 7-101 et seq. of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, while the TNC driver is logged into the network.

        H. A TNC driver shall carry proof of coverage satisfying
 2
    subsections B and C of this section with him or her at all times
 3
    during his or her use of a vehicle in connection with a
 4
    transportation network company's digital network. Proof of coverage
 5
    may be presented in electronic format. In the event of an accident,
    a TNC driver shall provide this insurance coverage information to
 6
 7
    the directly interested parties, automobile insurers and
    investigating police officers, upon request pursuant to Section 7-
 9
    102 et seq. of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Upon such
10
    request, a TNC driver shall also disclose to directly interested
11
    parties, automobile insurers, and investigating police officers
12
    whether he or she was logged on to the TNC's digital network or on a
13
    prearranged ride at the time of an accident.

        SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
