BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 20 of Title 73, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All events or exhibits properly scheduled and approved for individuals or groups in locations designated in the Oklahoma State Capitol or any of its public spaces or plazas eligible for events or exhibits shall be honored in the location and on the specific date and time so approved. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) shall provide any personnel or items required for controlling the location for the specified time and location reservation.

1	Cancellations for location and times reserved by an individual
2	or group shall only be allowed by the applicant or by OMES when an
3	emergency occurs that could endanger the individual or public safety
4	such as weather or structural damage to an approved area. Priority
5	shall be given to an applicant that is subject to cancellation for
6	an emergency shall be rescheduled as soon as practicable.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
