9	COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE
10	An Act relating to school employee payroll deductions; amending 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-139, as
11	amended by Section 1, Chapter 193, O.S.L. 2018 (70 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 5-139), which relates to
12	payroll deductions for professional organizations; subjecting certain payroll deductions and political
13	contributions to certain provisions; prohibiting certain deductions from exceeding one year without
14	reauthorization; prohibiting accrual of certain debt after certain request to terminate is provided;
15	requiring authorization for professional organization dues and political contributions to be on certain
16	form containing certain statement; requiring certain authorization to include certain information;
17	requiring a school district to confirm certain authorization; providing for expiration of certain
18	authorization if certain action is not taken in certain school year; providing for codification; and
19	declaring an emergency.

22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-139, as
 amended by Section 1, Chapter 193, O.S.L. 2018 (70 O.S. Supp. 2020,
 Section 5-139), is amended to read as follows:

Section 5-139. School districts shall make payroll deductions 4 5 for either or both professional organization dues and political contributions at the written request of any school employee subject 6 to the provisions of Section 2 of this act and shall transmit 7 deducted funds to the organization designated by the school district 8 9 employee. Such deductions shall be on a ten-month basis unless 10 otherwise designated by the employee organization but shall not 11 exceed one (1) year without reauthorization. However, a school employee may request at any time in writing, including by email or 12 fax, for the school district to immediately terminate or initiate 13 payroll deductions to a professional organization. Upon receipt of 14 any written request, the school district shall within five (5) 15 business days or by the next pay period, whichever is earlier, 16 17 terminate or initiate any future payroll deductions of the requesting school employee to a professional organization. 18 Upon receipt of a written request, the school district shall notify the 19 professional organization of the initiation or termination of 20 payroll deductions within fifteen (15) business days. If the 21 request is to terminate a deduction, the school district shall not 22 make any advance payments to any professional organization of any 23 future dues on behalf of the school employee, and no further debt 24

1 from the school employee to the professional organization shall 2 No school district policy or negotiated agreement shall accrue. place any other conditions or requirements, including but not 3 limited to personal hand delivery, upon any employee to initiate or 4 5 terminate any payroll deduction to a professional organization except for a written request as outlined in this section. Any 6 school district policy or provision in a negotiated agreement that 7 places additional conditions or requirements on initiation or 8 9 termination beyond those outlined in this section shall be null and 10 void. A school district which fails to terminate payroll deductions 11 for an employee in accordance with this section shall immediately 12 reimburse the employee the amount of all payroll deductions made by the school district after the employee's request, and the amount due 13 the employee shall double every thirty (30) days until paid in full. 14 A new section of law to be codified 15 SECTION 2. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-139a of Title 70, unless there 16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17

A. Authorization for professional organization dues and
political contributions as provided for in Section 5-139 of Title 70
of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be on a form prescribed by the
Secretary of Education and contain a statement in fourteen-point
boldface font reading:

23 "I am aware that I have a First Amendment right, as recognized24 by the U.S. Supreme Court, to refrain from joining and paying dues

1 or making political contributions to a professional employee organization. I further realize that membership and payment of dues 2 or political contributions are voluntary and that I may not be 3 discriminated against for my refusal to join or financially support 4 5 a professional employee organization. I hereby authorize my employer to deduct dues and/or political contributions from my 6 salary in the amounts specified in accordance with my professional 7 employee organization's bylaws. I understand that I may revoke this 8 9 authorization at any time."

10 Β. Authorization containing an employee's full name, position, 11 professional organization and signature shall be submitted to the school district. The school district shall confirm the 12 authorization by emailing the employee's school district-provided 13 email address and shall wait for confirmation of the authorization 14 before starting any deduction. If the employee does not possess a 15 school district-provided email address, the school district may use 16 other means it deems appropriate to confirm the authorization. 17

C. An authorization shall expire at the start of the first full pay period each school year unless it was authorized or reauthorized during the previous school year.

21 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 22 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
