14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Delete the title, enacting clause and entire bill
15 and replace with:

16 "An Act relating to memorial highway and bridge
17 designations; designating the Gold Star Families
18 Memorial Highway; designating the Randy Peterson
19 Memorial Highway; designating the Sgt. Michael A.
20 Crawford Memorial Highway; designating the Sgt.
21 Jason McCluskey Memorial Bridge; designating the Lt.
22 Heath Meyer #64 Memorial Highway; designating the
23 Thelma "Chincie" Ross WWII Chickasaw Code Talker
24 Memorial Bridge; designating the Sgt. Maj.
Christopher Nelms Memorial Bridge; designating the
Comanche Code Talker Trailway; requiring certain
markers; providing for codification; and providing
an effective date.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.287 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of U.S. Highway 277 beginning on the west side of
5 the H.E. Bailey Turnpike and extending west to the intersection of
6 U.S. Highway 62 in Comanche County shall be designated as the "Gold
7 Star Families Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
8 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
9 placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.288 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The section of U.S. Highway 69B beginning at the intersection of
14 Foley Avenue and extending north to the intersection of Selmon Road
15 within the municipal limits of Eufaula shall be designated as the
16 "Randy Peterson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
17 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
18 placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.289 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The section of U.S. Highway 266 beginning at the intersection
23 with U.S. Highway 75 and extending east to the eastern municipal
24 limit of Dewar within Okmulgee County shall be designated as the

1 "Sgt. Michael A. Crawford Memorial Highway". The Department of
2 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
3 name to be placed on the highway.

4 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.290 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The bridge over U.S. Highway 69 on U.S. Highway 270 within the
8 municipal limits of McAlester shall be designated as the "Sgt. Jason
9 McCluskey Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
10 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
11 the highway.

12 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.291 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The portion of Interstate 35 in the area one (1) mile north and
16 one (1) mile south of North 27th Street within the municipal limits
17 of Moore shall be designated as the "Lt. Heath Meyer #64 Memorial
18 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
19 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

20 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.292 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge located on State Highway 37 one-half (0.5) mile west
24 of the Stillwater Central Railroad crossing in the town of Tuttle in

1 Grady County shall be designated as the "Thelma "Chincie" Ross WWII
2 Chickasaw Code Talker Memorial Bridge". The Department of
3 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
4 name to be placed on the highway.

5 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.293 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The bridge over the Washita River on U.S. Highway 77 located
9 approximately one (1) mile west of Wynnewood in Garvin County shall
10 be designated as the "Sgt. Maj. Christopher Nelms Memorial Bridge".
11 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
12 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

13 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.294 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The section of State Highway 5 beginning at the intersection of
17 U.S. Highway 277 in Cotton County then extending east to the
18 intersection of North 7th Street in Walters shall be designated as
19 the "Comanche Code Talker Trailway". The Department of
20 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
21 name to be placed on the highway.

22 SECTION 9. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.287 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The section of U.S. Highway 277 beginning on the west side of
18 the H.E. Bailey Turnpike and extending west to the intersection of
19 U.S. Highway 62 in Comanche County shall be designated as the "Gold
20 Star Families Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
21 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
22 placed on the highway.

23 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.288 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of U.S. Highway 69B beginning at the intersection of
2 Foley Avenue and extending north to the intersection of Selmon Road
3 within the municipal limits of Eufaula shall be designated as the
4 "Randy Peterson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
5 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
6 placed on the highway.

7 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.289 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The section of U.S. Highway 266 beginning at the intersection
11 with U.S. Highway 75 and extending east to the eastern municipal
12 limit of Dewar within Okmulgee County shall be designated as the
13 "Sgt. Michael A. Crawford Memorial Highway". The Department of
14 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
15 name to be placed on the highway.

16 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.290 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The bridge over U.S. Highway 69 on U.S. Highway 270 within the
20 municipal limits of McAlester shall be designated as the "Sgt. Jason
21 McCluskey Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
22 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
23 the highway.

24 SECTION 14. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
