

1 Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) test and consult with a military
2 recruiter.

3 B. The ASVAB test shall be scheduled during normal school day
4 hours at a time that limits conflicts with extracurricular
5 activities.

6 C. Each public school district and public charter school shall
7 provide each student in grades ten through twelve and his or her
8 parent or legal guardian with the date, time and location of the
9 scheduled administration of the ASVAB test.

10 D. A public school district and public charter school may elect
11 not to provide the ASVAB test if the district or charter school
12 provides an alternative test that:

13 1. Assesses a student's aptitude for success in a career field
14 other than a career field that requires postsecondary education;

15 2. Is free to administer;

16 3. Requires minimal training and support of district or charter
17 school faculty and staff to administer the test; and

18 4. Provides the student with a professional interpretation of
19 the test results that allows the student to explore occupations that
20 are consistent with his or her interests and skills and to develop
21 strategies to attain career goals.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

23 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
