scheduled administration of the ASVAB test.

D. A public school district and public charter school may elect not to provide the ASVAB test if the district or charter school provides an alternative test that:

6 1. Assesses a student's aptitude for success in a career field7 other than a career field that requires postsecondary education;

8 2. Is free to administer;

9 3. Requires minimal training and support of district or charter10 school faculty and staff to administer the test; and

4. Provides the student with a professional interpretation of the test results that allows the student to explore occupations that are consistent with his or her interests and skills and to develop strategies to attain career goals.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

16 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 17 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
