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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2215.1 of Title 74, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. This act shall be known as the "Rural Tourism Protection
18	Act".
19	B. As used in this section, the term "change in services" means
20	the:
21	1. Reduction by fifty percent (50%) or more of the hours of
22	operation or services; or
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1 2. Closure of any state park, parkland or public recreation 2 facility under the jurisdiction and control of the Oklahoma Tourism 3 and Recreation Department.

C. Prior to making a change in services, the Department shall 4 5 provide sixty (60) days' notice to the governing authority of each municipality and county in which any part of the state park, 6 parkland, public recreation facility or recreational area is located 7 regarding the specific proposed change in services. The notice 8 9 required by this subsection shall be made in writing and sent to the 10 applicable chairperson of the county commissioners and the mayor of 11 the municipality.

D. Section 1 of this act shall not apply in cases of natural 12 13 disasters and acts of nature including, but not limited to, severe drought, flooding, wild fires, tornadoes, or earthquakes. 14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015. 15

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
