7	An Act relating to the Emergency and Transportation Revolving Fund; amending 69 O.S. 2011, Section 687.3,
8	as amended by Section 578, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (69 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 687.3), which relates to
9	creation of the Emergency and Transportation Revolving Fund; requiring the Statewide Circuit
10	Engineering Board to expend funds for the purpose of financing counties to purchase or convert to
11	compressed natural gas vehicles; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 687.3, as
16	amended by Section 578, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (69 O.S. Supp.
17	2014, Section 687.3), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 687.3. A. There is hereby created in the State
19	Treasury a revolving fund to be designated the "Emergency and
20	Transportation Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing
21	fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of
22	all monies received by any donations, deposits designated by law, or
23	appropriations. All monies accruing to the credit of said <u>the</u> fund
24	are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by any

1 qualified county or counties pursuant to subsection B of this 2 section for the purpose of funding emergency or transportation 3 projects of a county that are reimbursable and subsection C of this 4 section for the purpose of funding loans to purchase compressed 5 natural gas vehicles or convert fleet vehicles to compressed natural gas. No more than fifty percent (50%) of the fund's balance at the 6 7 beginning of each fiscal year shall be expended pursuant to subsection C of this section. The fund shall be invested in 8 9 whatever instruments are authorized by law for investments by the 10 State Treasurer and the interest earned by any investment of monies 11 from the fund shall be credited to the Statewide Circuit Engineering 12 District Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 687.2 of this 13 title for expenditure as provided by law. Expenditures from the Emergency and Transportation Revolving Fund shall be made upon 14 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as 15 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and 16 Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 17

B. The Statewide Circuit Engineering Board shall develop and adopt rules governing the application and qualification procedures for counties seeking funding pursuant to subsection A of this section. Such rules shall also specify criteria in determining reimbursable projects and the procedures for reimbursement of the fund upon completion of projects.

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2 and adopt rules governing application and qualification procedures 3 for counties requesting a loan pursuant to subsection A of this 4 section to purchase compressed natural gas vehicles or convert 5 existing fleet vehicles to compressed natural gas. 6 2. Loans shall be provided at no interest for a maximum term of 7 five (5) years. 8 3. Counties that borrow funds for the purpose of purchasing 9 compressed natural gas vehicles shall provide documentation showing 10 that an amount of gas-powered vehicles equal to or greater than 11 those purchased have been sold or otherwise disposed of to a 10 nongovernmental entity. 13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015. 14 SECTION 3.
