20	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 687.3, as

23	Section 687.3 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury

The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received 2 3 by any donations, deposits designated by law, or appropriations. All monies accruing to the credit of said the fund are hereby 4 5 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by any qualified county or counties pursuant to subsection B of this section for the 6 7 purpose of funding emergency or transportation projects of a county that are reimbursable and subsection C of this section for the 8 9 purpose of funding loans to purchase compressed natural gas vehicles 10 or convert fleet vehicles to compressed natural gas. No more than 11 fifty percent (50%) of the fund's balance at the beginning of each 12 fiscal year shall be expended pursuant to subsection C of this 13 section. The fund shall be invested in whatever instruments are 14 authorized by law for investments by the State Treasurer and the 15 interest earned by any investment of monies from the fund shall be 16 credited to the Statewide Circuit Engineering District Revolving 17 Fund created pursuant to Section 687.2 of this title for expenditure 18 as provided by law. Expenditures from the Emergency and 19 Transportation Revolving Fund shall be made upon warrants issued by 20 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with 21 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for 22 approval and payment.
