	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Protection
14	Against Sexual Exploitation by a Mental Health Services Provider
15	Act".
16	B. As used in the Protection Against Sexual Exploitation By a
17	Mental Health Services Provider Act:
18	"Therapeutic deception" means any act, scheme, plan or pattern
19	by a licensed mental health professional:
2 0	a. intended to cause a person to believe that performing,
21	or failing to perform, an act would result in serious
2 2	physical, financial or emotional harm or distress to
2 3	or physical restraint against any person, and

- b. that can reasonably be construed as being for the

  purpose of sexual gratification of the licensed mental

  health professional.
  - C. A licensed mental health professional as defined by Section 1-103 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes who engages in therapeutic deception of a patient or former patient shall be subject to any applicable criminal sanctions as follows:
  - 1. A single act of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental health professional with one current or former patient shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00);
  - 2. Multiple acts of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental health professional with one current or former patient shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00); and
  - 3. Multiple acts of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental health professional with two or more current or former patients shall be a felony punishable by a fine not exceeding Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00).
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
