10	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

13	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Protection

16	B. As used in the Protection Against Sexual Exploitation By a

18	"Therapeutic deception" means any act, scheme, plan or pattern

21	or failing to perform, an act would result in serious
2 2	physical, financial or emotional harm or distress to
2 3	or physical restraint against any person, and

- b. that can reasonably be construed as being for the purpose of sexual gratification of the licensed mental health professional.
- C. A licensed mental health professional as defined by Section 1-103 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes who engages in therapeutic deception of a patient or former patient shall be subject to any applicable criminal sanctions as follows:
- 1. A single act of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental health professional with one current or former patient shall be a felony punishable by a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) and the immediate revocation of the licensed mental health professional's license by the appropriate licensing board;
- 2. Multiple acts of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental health professional with one current or former patient shall be a felony punishable by a fine not exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) and the immediate revocation of the licensed mental health professional's license by the appropriate licensing board; and
- 3. Multiple acts of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental health professional with two or more current or former patients shall be a felony punishable by a fine not exceeding Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) and the immediate revocation of the licensed mental health professional's license by the appropriate licensing board.
