1. "Sexual exploitation" means a pattern, practice or scheme of conduct, which may include sexual conduct that can reasonably be construed as being for the purposes of sexual arousal or gratification or sexual abuse of any person. The term does not include obtaining information about the sexual history of a patient within standard accepted practice while treating a sexual or marital dysfunction; and

- 2. "Therapeutic deception" means a representation by a mental health services provider that sexual conduct with, or sexual exploitation by, the mental health services provider is consistent with, or a part of, the treatment of a patient or former patient.
- B. A licensed mental health services provider who engages in sexual exploitation or therapeutic deception of a patient or former patient shall be subject to any applicable criminal sanctions as follows:
- 1. A single act of sexual exploitation or therapeutic deception by a mental health services provider with one current or former patient shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00);
- 2. Multiple acts of sexual conduct, sexual exploitation or therapeutic deception by a mental health services provider with one current or former patient shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00); and
