15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-101 of Title 43A, unless
18	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Protection
20	Against Sexual Exploitation by a Mental Health Services Provider
21	Act".
22	B. As used in the Protection Against Sexual Exploitation By a
23	Mental Health Services Provider Act:

1 "Therapeutic deception" means any act, scheme, plan or pattern
2 by a licensed mental health professional:

3 intended to cause a person to believe that performing, a. or failing to perform, an act would result in serious 4 5 physical, financial or emotional harm or distress to or physical restraint against any person, and 6 7 that can reasonably be construed as being for the b. purpose of sexual gratification of the licensed mental 8 9 health professional.

10 C. A licensed mental health professional as defined by Section 11 1-103 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes who engages in 12 therapeutic deception of a patient or former patient shall be 13 subject to any applicable criminal sanctions as follows:

A single act of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental
 health professional with one current or former patient shall be a
 felony punishable by a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars
 (\$5,000.00) and the immediate revocation of the licensed mental
 health professional's license by the appropriate licensing board;

Multiple acts of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental 20 health professional with one current or former patient shall be a 21 felony punishable by a fine not exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars 22 (\$10,000.00) and the immediate revocation of the licensed mental 23 health professional's license by the appropriate licensing board; 24 and

Multiple acts of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental
 health professional with two or more current or former patients
 shall be a felony punishable by a fine not exceeding Twenty Thousand
 Dollars (\$20,000.00) and the immediate revocation of the licensed
 mental health professional's license by the appropriate licensing
 board.

D. Each licensing board with jurisdiction over the professions
specified in Section 1-103 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes
shall promptly report complaints of sexual exploitation made by
patients to a local law enforcement agency for criminal
investigation.
SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
