7	An Act relating to insurance; defining terms; requiring coverage for a certain drug as a preferred
8	drug; prohibiting cost sharing from exceeding specified levels; prohibiting certain acts relating
9	to cost sharing; prohibiting prior authorization to require first use of certain drugs; authorizing prior
10	authorization for certain drugs under certain circumstances; providing for codification; and
11	providing an effective date.
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as section 6060.21 of Title 36, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering reads as follows:
18	As used in Sections 1 through 3 of this act:
19	1. "Opioid analgesic drug product" means a drug product in the
20	opioid drug class prescribed to treat moderate to severe pain or
21	other conditions, whether in immediate release or extended
22	release/long-acting form and whether or not combined with other drug
23	substances to form a single drug product or dosage form;
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2. "Abuse-deterrent opioid analgesic drug product" means a
 brand or generic opioid analgesic drug product approved by the U.S.
 Food and Drug Administration with abuse-deterrence labeling claims
 that indicate the drug product is expected to result in a meaningful
 reduction in abuse;

3. "Cost sharing" means any coverage limit, copayment,
7 coinsurance, deductible or other out-of-pocket expense requirements;

8 4. "Health benefit plan" means any plan or arrangement as
9 defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the
10 Oklahoma Statutes.

11 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as section 6060.22 of Title 36, unless 13 there is created a duplication in numbering reads as follows:

A. A health plan shall provide coverage for abuse-deterrent
opioid analgesic drugs as preferred drugs on the formulary,
preferred drug list or other lists of similar construct.

B. Cost sharing for abuse-deterrent opioid analgesic drug
products shall not exceed the lowest cost sharing level applied to
prescription drugs.

20 C. An increase in patient cost sharing or other disincentives 21 for prescribers or dispensers shall not be allowed to achieve 22 compliance in this section.

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1SECTION 3.NEW LAWA new section of law to be codified2in the Oklahoma Statutes as section 6060.23 of Title 36, unless3there is created a duplication in numbering reads as follows:

A. Any prior authorization requirements or other utilization
review measures for opioid analgesic drug products on the market and
any service denials made pursuant to such requirements or measures
shall not require first use of non-abuse-deterrent opioid analgesic
drug products in order to access opioid analgesic drug products with
abuse-deterrent properties.

B. An insurer or health benefit plan may apply prior
authorization requirements to abuse-deterrent opioid analgesic drug
products, provided that such requirements are applied to non-abusedeterrent versions of said opioid.

14 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
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
