SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10-111.2 of Title 43A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A vulnerable adult as defined pursuant to Section 10-103 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes shall have a cause of action against any perpetrator of abuse, neglect or exploitation and may recover actual and punitive damages. The action may be brought in any court of competent jurisdiction by the vulnerable adult or the adult's guardian, by a person or organization acting on behalf of the vulnerable adult with the consent of the adult or the adult's guardian or by the personal representative of the estate of a
