NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4100.8 of Title 59, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 13 The provisions of this section shall apply to a member of 14 15 the Armed Forces of the United States, who is on active duty, and 16 their spouse, who is at the time of a military transfer into this state or upon entering this state to reside in this state on 17 military orders and for employment purposes. Such military person 18 or spouse who is duly licensed or certified in his or her occupation 19 or profession in another state, and who is in good standing with the 20 administrative body of such other state with authority for such 21 license or certification, and who is actively employed in such 22 occupation or profession upon receiving military orders to enter or 23

reside in this state for military duty or employment purposes, shall

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- receive an automatic reciprocal license or certification in this

 state for the duration of the military duty and employment in this

 state by the appropriate administrative body, state agency or

 official in this state that has authority over the occupational or

 professional license.
 - B. Application for an automatic reciprocal license or certification authorized in subsection A of this section shall be made not later than fourteen (14) days prior to entering this state on forms provided by the licensing or credentialing authority in this state. Payment of fees and submission of necessary documentation shall be required as part of the application process. Upon receipt of the appropriate fees, forms and complete application process an automatic license or certification shall be issued to such person for a term to be determined by the licensing or credentialing authority in this state.
 - C. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections A and B of this section for an automatic reciprocal license or certification, a person may be required to complete other requirements if it is found that the licensing or certificate requirements of the other state are not sufficiently equivalent to those of this state.
 - D. Every administrative body, state agency director or official with authority over any occupational or professional license shall promulgate rules, forms and establish application processes and fees to implement the provisions of this act.
