12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-901b, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 11-901b. A. The operator of every vehicle, while
16	driving, shall devote their <u>his or her</u> full time and attention to
17	such driving. An operator of a vehicle cannot be communicating with
18	a handheld electronic device, either verbally or by typing an email
19	or text during the physical operation of a motor vehicle.
20	No law enforcement officer shall issue a citation under this
21	section unless the law enforcement officer observes that the
22	operator of the vehicle is involved in an accident or observes the
23	operator of the vehicle driving in such a manner that poses an
24	

1	articulable danger to other persons on the roadway that is not
2	otherwise specified in statute.
3	B. The fine for violating the provisions of subsection A of
4	this section shall not exceed the statutory penalty of a
5	misdemeanor.
6	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
