6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to district court judgment dockets;  
8 amending 11 O.S. 2011, Section 27-122, which relates  
9 to enforcement of payment of fines or costs;  
10 prohibiting fee for certain certification and entry;  
11 and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 27-122, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 27-122. A. If a defendant who is financially able  
16 refuses or neglects to pay a fine or costs or both, payment may be  
17 enforced:

18 1. By imprisonment until the same shall be satisfied at the  
19 rate of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per day; or

20 2. In the same manner as is prescribed in subsection B of this  
21 section for a defendant who is without means to make such payment.

22 B. If the defendant is without means to pay the fine or costs,  
23 the municipal judge may direct the total amount due to be entered  
24 upon the court minutes and to be certified to the district court in

1 the county where the situs of the municipal government is located,  
2 where it shall be entered upon the district court judgment docket  
3 and shall have the full force and effect of a district court  
4 judgment. No fee shall be required by the clerk of the district  
5 court for such certification and entry upon the district court  
6 judgment docket. The same remedies shall be available for the  
7 enforcement of the judgment as are available to any other judgment  
8 creditor.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
