AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to prevention and control of disease; prohibiting compulsory immunization by state entity or political subdivision; prohibiting penalties; prohibiting inquiry into or disclosure of immunization status; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-502.5 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no state entity or political subdivision of this state shall, through direct or indirect means, compel or coerce any person under its jurisdiction to receive any immunization. No person shall be punished through any means including, but not limited to, a monetary fine for such person's refusal to receive any immunization. Additionally, no state entity or political subdivision, or employee or agent thereof, shall inquire into a person's immunization status or disclose any details of the person's immunization status to any person or entity.

4	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
