13	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
14	A. The Human Capital Management Division of the Office of
15	Management and Enterprise Services shall develop a system that
16	provides a differential bonus for state employees who have earned
17	degrees or certifications that were previously required for their
18	positions but are no longer considered mandatory for the position.
19	B. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
20	Services shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this
21	act.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
