All projects related to the 17 Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding shall have signage that 18 is displayed in a prominently visible location at the project site 19 such as, but not limited to, a cornerstone. Such signage shall 20 reference the Joint Committee on Pandemic Relief Funding and the 21 year completed. 22 SECTION 2.
