13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.13 of Title 56, unless
15	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority and the Department of
17	Human Services shall submit a report to the President Pro Tempore of
18	the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives examining
19	how the state utilizes Medicaid funding for the provision of child
20	welfare services. Such report shall include examples from other
21	states using Medicaid funding for the provision of child welfare
22	services.
23	B. The report required by subsection A of this section shall be
24	submitted on or before December 31, 2017.

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        SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
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    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
