6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to child welfare; directing Oklahoma  
8 Health Care Authority and Department of Human  
9 Services to report certain information; specifying  
10 distribution; requiring submission by certain date;  
11 providing for codification; providing an effective  
12 date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.13 of Title 56, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority and the Department of  
18 Human Services shall submit a report to the President Pro Tempore of  
19 the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives examining  
20 how the state utilizes Medicaid funding for the provision of child  
21 welfare services. Such report shall include examples from other  
22 states using Medicaid funding for the provision of child welfare  
23 services.

24 B. The report required by subsection A of this section shall be  
submitted on or before December 31, 2017.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
3 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
