NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.12 of Title 70, unless 13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 14 15 A. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services shall develop and make available to school districts training on 16 social-emotional learning. Training in social-emotional learning 17 shall include but is not limited to the following areas: 18 1. Understanding emotion vocabulary; 19 Understanding facial expressions of emotion; 20 2. Understanding coping skills. "Coping skills" means 21 constantly changing cognitive and behavioral efforts to manage 22 specific external and/or internal demands that are appraised as 23

taxing or exceeding the resources of the person; and

1	4. Understanding conflict resolution.
2	B. The Department may work with one or more nonprofit
3	organizations that have proven expertise in the development of
4	standards and curriculum and delivery of teacher professional
5	development in social-emotional learning for the purposes of
6	developing and providing guidelines, materials, resources and
7	professional development.
8	C. The Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services
9	shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the provisions of this
10	section.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
12	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
