3 SENATE BILL NO. 70

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5 An Act relating to common education; directing the
6 State Auditor and Inspector to perform a performance
7 audit on the State Department of Education; requiring
8 the audit to be performed during certain fiscal year;
9 authorizing the State Auditor and Inspector to take
10 custody of certain records; directing the State
11 Auditor and Inspector to meet with the State
12 Superintendent of Public Instruction and the State
13 Board of Education to review certain report;
14 requiring the report to include certain responses;
15 directing filing of report; providing for posting of
16 report on certain website; providing for
17 codification; providing an effective date; and
18 declaring an emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-124 of Title 70, unless there
22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 A. The State Auditor and Inspector shall perform an
24 independent, comprehensive performance audit on the State Department
25 of Education during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017.

26 B. The State Auditor and Inspector shall have the power to take
27 custody of any records necessary to the performance of the audit but
28 shall minimize actual physical removal of or denial of access to
29 such records.

1 C. At the conclusion of the audit, the State Auditor and
2 Inspector shall meet with the State Superintendent of Public
3 Instruction and the State Board of Education to review the audit
4 report to be issued. The report, when issued, shall include any
5 responses to the audit which the State Superintendent of Public
6 Instruction or the State Board of Education wishes to have included.

7 D. The State Auditor and Inspector shall file the report with
8 the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the
9 Speaker of the House of Representatives. The State Board of
10 Education shall post the completed report to its website.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
