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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-124 of Title 70, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. The State Auditor and Inspector shall perform an
19	independent, comprehensive performance audit on the State Department
20	of Education during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017.
21	B. The State Auditor and Inspector shall have the power to take
22	custody of any records necessary to the performance of the audit but
23	shall minimize actual physical removal of or denial of access to
24	such records.

1	C. At the conclusion of the audit, the State Auditor and
2	Inspector shall meet with the State Superintendent of Public
3	Instruction and the State Board of Education to review the audit
4	report to be issued. The report, when issued, shall include any
5	responses to the audit which the State Superintendent of Public
6	Instruction or the State Board of Education wishes to have included.
7	D. The State Auditor and Inspector shall file the report with
8	the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the
9	Speaker of the House of Representatives. The State Board of
10	Education shall post the completed report to its website.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
12	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
