8 An Act relating to the State Board of Education;  
9 directing the State Board of Education to issue a  
10 request for proposals for a statewide student  
11 information system by certain date; directing the  
12 board to adopt certain system; directing the system  
13 to be administered on a pilot program basis for  
14 certain number of years; directing the Board to  
15 develop certain structure to incentivize  
16 participation in the pilot program; directing the  
17 Board to study, develop and establish certain  
18 policies; allowing the Board to implement certain  
19 system on a statewide basis; allowing the Board to  
20 establish certain fee for participation; providing  
21 for codification; providing an effective date; and  
22 declaring an emergency.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-169 of Title 70, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Board of Education shall issue a request for  
proposals on or before December 31, 2019, for the selection of a  
statewide student information system.

1 B. The Board shall adopt a statewide student information system  
2 from the selected proposals that were submitted pursuant to  
3 subsection A of this section.

4 C. The statewide student information system selected pursuant  
5 to this section shall be administered on a pilot program basis for  
6 two (2) years. The Board shall develop a structure to incentivize  
7 school districts to participate in the pilot program; however,  
8 participation shall not be required. As part of the pilot program,  
9 the Board shall study, develop and establish policies for data  
10 inventory and data elements including the definition of data fields  
11 for the student information system.

12 D. Based on the success of the pilot program, the Board may  
13 implement the student information system on a statewide basis, at  
14 which time participation shall be required for all school districts  
15 in the state. The Board may establish a fee for school district  
16 participation in the statewide student information system.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

18 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
