18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 3-160, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 3-160. A. In developing and implementing a state
22 student record system, as required in Subsection E of Section 18-
23 200.1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and as needed to comply
24 with the tracking and reporting requirements of the Elementary and
Secondary Education Act of ~~2001~~ 1965 (ESEA), P.L. No. ~~107-110~~ 114-
95, ~~also known as the "No Child Left Behind Act of 2001"~~ as
reauthorized by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) of 2015, the

1 State Department of Education shall construct the system to contain
2 the following elements and comply with the following standards and
3 compliance capabilities:

4 1. ~~Extensible Markup Language (XML), which defines common data~~
5 ~~formats used during communication between disparate systems~~ Industry
6 recognized standards for the transmission and storage of data;

7 2. Web services protocol developed by the World Wide Web
8 Consortium, which enables systems that are physically separated but
9 connected to the Internet to be combined to permit complex
10 operations;

11 3. ~~Schools Interoperability Framework (SIF) version 1.5~~
12 ~~specifications, or any updated versions of the specifications,~~
13 Industry recognized standards for the transmission of education data
14 which enable school district software management systems to
15 communicate with each other. The student record system shall
16 include, but not be limited to, the specifications for course
17 identifiers, state standard formatting, content formatting, and
18 assessment formatting specification;

19 4. United States Department of Education ~~Performance-Based Data~~
20 ~~Management Initiative (PBDMI)~~ EDFacts data exchange guidelines with
21 data elements capable of providing reporting on federal educational
22 programs; and

23 5. Defined state data codes to ensure consistent reporting from
24 school districts including, but not limited to, data codes for

1 course identifiers, entries, gains, and losses. Current data codes
2 for teacher certification and the Oklahoma Cost Accounting System
3 shall be extended to match other defined data codes.

4 B. ~~By the 2005-2006 school year, any~~ Any student information
5 system and any instructional management system used by school
6 districts in the state shall comply with the ~~Extensible Markup~~
7 ~~Language (XML) standards and the Schools Interoperability Framework~~
8 ~~(SIF) version 1.5 specifications, or any updated versions of the~~
9 ~~specifications~~ implementation schedule and industry recognized
10 standards selected by the State Department of Education.

11 C. The State Department of Education shall have the authority
12 to define requirements for the submission of data elements for the
13 student information systems and instructional management systems
14 used by school districts statewide in compliance with state and
15 federal statutes.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
