12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 20 O.S. 2011, Section 92.1, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 92.1. A. The state is hereby divided into twenty-six
15	(26) district court judicial districts with the number of authorized
16	districts and district judges to be as provided in Sections $\frac{2}{92.22}$
17	through <del>27</del> <u>92.27</u> of this <del>act</del> <u>title</u> .
18	B. Pursuant to the authority provided by Section 8 of Article
19	VII of the Oklahoma Constitution, a district judge shall have, in
20	addition to the qualifications required by such section and as part
21	of his or her experience as a licensed practicing attorney,
22	experience as lead counsel in a minimum of three (3) jury trials
23	brought to verdict prior to filing for such office or appointment.
