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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-121 of Title 26, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. The Secretary of the State Election Board may join the State
18	of Oklahoma as a member in one or more multistate voter list
19	maintenance organizations including, but not limited to, the
20	Electronic Registration Information Center (ERIC) or its successor.
21	The Secretary is authorized to expend funds as available for
22	membership fees, dues and other expenses related to such membership.
23	B. Upon membership in an organization as provided in subsection
24	A of this section, the Secretary of the State Election Board may

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1 provide voter registration data to the organization and the 2 Department of Public Safety may provide motor vehicle license data 3 to the organization if such data is required to be provided as a condition of membership. The voter registration data and motor 4 5 vehicle license data described in this subsection may include a person's name, address, date of birth, driver license or state 6 identification number, last four digits of a social security number 7 or any other data required by the organization. The transmission 8 9 and storage of such data shall be done in a secure manner.

C. If a multistate voter list maintenance organization of which this state is a member identifies Oklahoma residents who are citizens of the United States eligible to vote but not yet registered, the Secretary of the State Election Board may notify such citizens about the procedure for becoming a registered voter in this state. The Secretary may delegate the contacting of such citizens to the secretary of the appropriate county election board.

D. If a multistate voter list maintenance organization of which 17 this state is a member provides United States Postal Service 18 National Change of Address data regarding registered voters who have 19 changed their address of residence within the state, the Secretary 20 of the State Election Board may use the data pursuant to the 21 provisions of Sections 4-118.1, 4-120.2 or 7-115.1 of Title 26 of 22 the Oklahoma Statutes or the federal National Voter Registration 23 24 Act.

1	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.
2	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
4	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
