14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 2-201, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 2-201. A. A Commissioner of Mental Health and
17	Substance Abuse Services shall be appointed by the Board of Mental
18	Health and Substance Abuse Services Governor. The Commissioner may
19	only be removed by the Board <u>Governor</u> for cause. The Commissioner
20	shall meet at least one of the following qualifications:
21	1. Possession of a Doctor of Medicine Degree and a license to
22	practice medicine in this state;
23	2. Possession of an Osteopathic Medicine Degree and a license
24	to practice medicine in this state;

- 1 3. Possession of a Doctor of Public Health Degree;
 - 4. Possession of a Doctoral Degree in Psychology and a license to practice psychology in this state;
 - 5. Possession of a Master of Public Health Degree and a minimum of five (5) years of supervisory experience in the administration of health services; or
 - 6. Possession of a Master of Arts or Master's Degree in Business Administration, Social Science or a related field and a minimum of five (5) years of supervisory experience in the administration of health services.
 - B. The salary of the Commissioner shall be fixed by the Board Governor.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
